In addition to the COAT activities, our President Randy Delap, has arranged for the Registers, aka "COAT Celebrities" to Hang Out in Unicoi County for some good Northeast Tennessee fun.

On Tuesday the 6<sup>th</sup>, we will load up around 3:45. We will begin with a ride to the top of the mountain via I-26.
